This M.A. in Local Church Ministry program consists of 15 competencies. To earn this degree, you must complete each of the 15 competencies with either Mastery or Proficiency Completion (the equivalent of no lower than a final grade of B in a traditional academic model). The credit equivalencies for each competency are listed to the right of each competency.

TOTAL COMPETENCIES TO GRADUATE: 15

Every competency shown above has several competency modules or parts (e.g., DLC 5101, DLC 5102, etc). Students may register for the entire competency in a given semester (e.g., DLC 5100 which comes with all the parts DLC 5101, DLC 5102, and DLC 5103--3 credit equivalencies) or register for part of the competency (e.g., DLC 5100 with the goal of completing just the first part DLC 5101 -- 1 credit equivalency). Ultimately, you will complete 42 credit equivalencies, consistent with many other M.A. programs in seminary education. But again, earning this degree is not based upon earning credits, but upon your mastery of the competencies needed in ministry. Complete all 15 and earn your degree. Complete all 15 with no more than one Proficient Completion grade and earn *Honors Graduate* distinction.

Students may not be enrolled simultaneously in both Deploy programs, the MA Local Church Ministry and MDiv General Ministry. Students may be able to change programs from the MA to the MDiv (or vice versa), but this cannot occur in the final semester of a student's program.
